RE: HB0551 – Broadband Expansion Incentive Act of 2023 (Support)

The Office of the Attorney General urges a favorable report on House Bill 551, Governor Moore's Broadband Expansion Incentive Act of 2023. This legislation ensures that Maryland most effectively deploys federal broadband infrastructure dollars to close the digital divide and ensure that all Marylanders have access to affordable, high-speed internet. If enacted, House Bill 551 will allow Maryland companies to better deploy federal broadband infrastructure dollars by 1) creating a 5 year moratorium on the collection of the sales and use tax for broadband infrastructure equipment, and 2) ending state taxation of federal broadband grants as income which began this tax year as a result of the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.

For the foregoing reasons, the Office of the Attorney General urges a favorable report on House Bill 551.
