Subject: **Request for FAVORABLE Report** – HB0140 – State Personnel – Spouses of Active Duty Service Members – Hiring Preferences

Dear Chair Barnes and distinguished members of the Appropriations Committee:

On behalf of the members of the Maryland Military Coalition (MMC) and as its President, I write to recommend a **FAVORABLE report** by the Committee on *HB0140 – State Personnel – Spouses of Active Duty Service Members – Hiring Preferences*, sponsored by Delegate Mike Rogers. This legislation will require an appointing authority to apply a credit on a selection test in the State Personnel Management System for the spouse of an active-duty service member. The bill clearly defines "active duty spouse," defines an eligible veteran as one who has served honorably in any branch of the uniformed services and defines "uniformed services" consistent with 38 U.S. Code § 4303 and 20 C.F.R. § 1002.5 (o).

This bill is a positive step in aligning the State Personnel Management System with not only the Maryland Joins Forces focus area of Employment but also the White House Joining Forces initiative to reduce underemployment of active duty spouses. According to the latest Department of Defense data, the active duty military spouse unemployment rate is about 21 percent¹ compared to the national unemployment rate of 3.7 percent² and Maryland's unemployment rate of 1.9 percent.³

There are currently 14,292 active-duty spouses in Maryland.⁴ These spouses represent a pool of talented personnel who may be available to fill vacancies in state government. A spousal

preference would not only facilitate hiring them but also recognize the sacrifices they make to support active-duty personnel and national security.

The Maryland Military Coalition **strongly supports** HB0140 and asks for a *FAVORABLE* report from the Appropriations Committee. This bill supports the Moore-Miller Administration's Year of the Military Families, helping to move Maryland to the forefront of supporting active-duty spouses in the United States.

The Maryland Military Coalition is a registered non-profit, non-partisan advocacy organization comprised of prominent Maryland-based veteran and military groups, representing over 150,000 service-connected individuals, including those currently serving, veterans, retirees and their families, caregivers, and survivors.

We want to thank Delegate Mike Rogers for sponsoring this legislation and his continued strong support of the uniformed services community, in particular, active-duty spouses, in Maryland.
