## **Testimony of Delegate Dana Jones Before the Appropriations Committee**

## In Support of HB 914 Winery and Vineyard Economic Development Grant Program - Modifications March 7th 2024, 1:00 pm

Chair Barnes, Vice Chair Chang, and my friends on the Appropriations Committee,

I come before you today to introduce House Bill 914 Winery and Vineyard Economic Development Grant Program - Modifications which modifies the grant program Maryland instituted two years ago. This legislation consists of minor technical fixes that the Department of Commerce and the Maryland Wineries Association have requested.

The Development grant fund promotes Maryland Wineries and vineyards, boosts tourism, local agriculture, and helps to preserve our open spaces. These technical changes give Commerce more flexibility to administer the fund, removing the date that applications must be submitted by and the date that the applications must be awarded by and gives Commerce the discretion to set those dates. House Bill 914 will improve the administration of this grant program and allow small business owners to benefit to the full extent they are eligible.

The Department of Commerce has submitted a letter in favor of these modifications and last week the Senate cross-file, SB 746, was unanimously voted out of Senate Finance.

With that, I respectfully request a favorable report on HB 914.
