

Income Tax – Technical Corrections SB678

What this bill does: Repeal obsolete provisions concerning income tax and correcting an erroneous cross-reference.

This bill makes a few small corrections to the Tax General article, including a reference that only applies to Fiscal Year 1990 and another that erroneously references the incorrect Subtitle in the Housing and Community Development Article.

Correcting the erroneous cross-reference ensures legal accuracy and prevents confusion in interpreting and applying relevant sections of the law.

Why this bill is important: By addressing technical corrections, the bill supports the efficiency of government processes, ensuring that laws are accurate and reflective of the intended policies.

I urge you to support the passage of this legislation. By doing so, we contribute to a more effective and clear tax code.

I look forward to working with the General Assembly on this important legislation.

I urge a favorable report on SB678.
