Thank you for the opportunity to present SB 852. This is a local bill that requires a Member of the Washington County Board of Education to be a resident of Washington County for at least 6 months and a resident of the state for at least 12 months immediately preceding the date the Member takes office. Additionally, SB 852 requires the Board of Education Member to maintain a primary residence in Washington County during their term.
