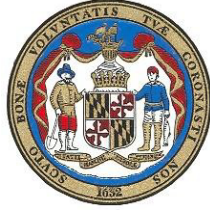

**Testimony of the Maryland State Treasurer's Office**

**House Bill 1503: Election Law – Campaign Finance Activities – State Treasurer**

**Position: Favorable**

**Senate Education, Energy, and the Environment Committee**

**March 27, 2024**

For many years, Maryland law has generally prohibited the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Comptroller, and General Assembly from fundraising during legislative session. While the State Treasurer has not been prohibited from such work, State Treasurers have not historically engaged in fundraising while in office. House Bill 1503 closes a potential loophole by ensuring that the State Treasurer is subject to the same restrictions as other State officials. Given that the State Treasurer is elected by the General Assembly, establishing parity in this manner better protects all involved against undue outside pressure.
