Stream and Watershed Restoration – Stream Restoration Contractor Licensing and Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Restoration and Funding (Whole Watershed Act)

Dear Committee Members:

Please oppose SB0969. I have heard proponents of climate change policies in their testimonies in Annapolis state that “good governance” is needed to ensure that the public private partnerships (P3) are meeting UNAgenda21 climate goals.
