Does your office have any feedback or a position on what the fiscal cost may be for HB 139 in light of the attached bill, as amended? As evidenced by the amendments, the bill is considerably revised and the [current fiscal note](#) is likely no longer representative because the OHEP provisions have been removed.

The amended bill only adds gas or electric utilities to the section of the Real Property Article that already requires landlords to provide a copy of the utility bill to tenants.
