## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 196 (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "requiring" in line 7 down through "date;" in line 8; and strike beginning with "person" in line 8 down through "belt" in line 10 and substitute "civil action for damages based on a failure to ensure that an occupant of a school bus was wearing a seat belt".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in lines 3 and 10, in each instance, strike the bracket; strike beginning with "**A**" in line 10 down through "**MOTION**" in line 12; in line 13, strike the first set of brackets; in the same line, strike "(**D**)"; in lines 15, 17, and 19, in each instance, strike the bracket; in lines 15, 17, and 19, strike "(**E**)", "(**F**)", and "(**G**)", respectively; in line 29, strike "(**1**)"; and in the same line, strike "**OCTOBER 1, 2024**" and substitute "<u>JULY 1, 2027</u>".

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 32 on page 3 through line 2 on page 4, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 25, strike "(1)"; and strike in their entirety lines 28 through 30, inclusive.

On page 6, after line 9, insert:

# "(4) <u>THE FAILURE OF A SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR TO ENSURE THAT</u> <u>AN OCCUPANT OF A SCHOOL BUS WAS WEARING A SEAT BELT MAY NOT BE THE</u>
