

Bill: HB 420: State and Local Parks – Play Area Accessibility – Communication Boards

On behalf of the Maryland Speech Language Hearing Association (MSHA), representing speech language pathologists and audiologists across Maryland, we support HB 420. Collectively, we elevate and engage members to strive for excellence in serving those impacted by communication and related disorders through advocacy, equity, education, interprofessional collaboration, and leadership development.

House Bill 420 would require the Department of Natural Resources and local governing bodies to construct communication boards in public play areas.
