AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after "manner;" insert "providing that certain real estate licensees are not liable to certain parties under certain circumstances;"; and after line 7, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

<u>Article - Business Occupations and Professions</u>

Section 17-101(a) and (k)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2018 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 19, insert:

"Article – Business Occupations and Professions

<u>17–101.</u>

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (k) <u>"Licensee" means a licensed real estate broker, a licensed associate real estate broker, or a licensed real estate salesperson."</u>

On page 2, after line 10, insert:

"(4) "LICENSEE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 17–101 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.";

On page 3, after line 19, insert:

"(4) A LICENSEE ENGAGED IN A REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION
SUBJECT TO ENFORCEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS NOT LIABLE TO ANY
PARTY TO THE TRANSACTION FOR DAMAGES OR HARM ARISING FROM AN
ENFORCEMENT ACTION.".
