## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 338

(First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "C" insert "Fraternal or Sororal Organization and"; in line 3, strike "License" and substitute "Licenses"; in line 4, after "Class C" insert "(fraternal or sororal organization) or a Class C"; and in line 14, after "Section" insert "29–1001 and".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 21, insert:

#### "29–1001.

- (b) The Board may issue the license for use by a lodge or chapter of a nonprofit and nationwide fraternal or sororal organization that:
  - (1) is composed of inducted members;
- (2) was operating in the county for at least 1 year before the license application was made;
- (3) has at least 25 members paying dues of at least \$15 per year per member; and
- (4) owns or operates a home or clubhouse that is principally for the use of its members and guests when accompanied by members.
- (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail at the place described in the license for on–premises consumption.

- (d) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days as set out for a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license under § 29–2004 of this title.
- (e) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY PURCHASE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM A RETAIL DEALER.
  - **(F)** The annual license fee is \$316.".
