Re: HB835 – FAV - Calvert County Procurement Local Preference Written Testimony

Dear Delegation:

Our sincere gratitude goes to each of you and your staff for the remarkable job of keeping us well informed as important matters progress. We write today to **SUPPORT** HB835 and request a **FAVORABLE** Committee report.

This Bill represents our request that Title 6 of the <u>Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, Calvert County (Article 5)</u> provide authority for the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County to adopt a local preference in competitive solicitations. The Bill requires meaningful taxpayer input by public hearing conducted in accordance with Sections 9-105 and 9-106 of the *Local Government Article* of the <u>Md. Ann. Code</u>. The request for authority is in recognition that the calculus of finding balance in cost and benefit to County taxpayers is a complex formula that will likely require agility in listening to constituents and revisiting until appropriate balance is achieved.
