House Bill 858 - UNFAVORABLE Health and Government Operations Committee

Honorable Chair, Vice Chair, and Members of the Health and Government Operations Committee;

Please give House Bill 858 an Unfavorable report.

House Bill 858 would require someone who wants an abortion to wait even longer to get one. This legislation would create a major hardship for anyone who works, takes care of children, relies on public transportation, relies on others for rides, or is at risk of harm from their partner.
