

TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 691

Legally Protected Health Care - Gender-Affirming Treatment Before the Health and Government Operations Committee By Lyla Martin, Intern, Maryland Citizens' Health Initiative February 21, 2024

Chair Peña-Melnyk, Vice-Chair Cullison, and Members of the Health and Government Operations Committee, thank you for this opportunity to testify in support of HB 691 on behalf of Maryland Citizens' Health Initiative, a nonprofit advocacy organization with a mission to ensure access to quality, affordable health care. Special thank you to Delegate Moon and Delegate Martinez for sponsoring this legislation. We strongly support HB 691 to protect gender-affirming care and establish Maryland as a safe haven for transgender people. As it stands now, gender-affirming care is not included in the definition of "legally protected healthcare." Twenty-two states so far have enacted bans on gender affirming care. Our neighbors, Pennsylvania, Ohio, and West Virginia, have either banned or proposed bans on gender affirming care. HB 691 would make Maryland a safe-haven by ensuring that access to gender affirming care is protected from out-of-state litigation, as eleven states and the District of Columbia have already done. With HB 691 Maryland can become a more equitable and inclusive state. We strongly urge a favorable report on HB 691 and thank you for your time and consideration on this matter.
