Dentures play an essential part in someone's health. This study will help identify gaps in coverage for those needing full or partial dentures and the appropriate reimbursement rates. "Removable dentures have the advantage that they can be readily added to in the event of further tooth loss, which may be particularly relevant for older adults. Partial dentures which optimize support, retention, and stability can function very successfully and significantly improve patients' oral health-related quality of life." (Friel & Waia, 2020)
