Dear Chair Peña-Melnyk and Committee Members:

The Maryland Department of Health respectfully submits this letter of support for Senate Bill 237 - State Board for Certification of Residential Child Care Program Professionals - Sunset Extension. This legislation extends the sunset date of the Board from July 1, 2025 to July 1, 2028.

The Department is taking a uniform approach to recommended sunset extensions for our independent health occupations boards. A more thorough evaluation of the Health Occupations Boards is needed at this time to assess ongoing concerns related to licensure, technology, and administrative functions. MDH believes a three year sunset extension allows ample time for MDH and the Boards to examine these functions and return to the General Assembly in 2026 with an update.
