The Women's Law Center of Maryland (WLC) supports *House Bill 583 - Center for Firearm Violence Prevention - Establishment*. The bill would establish the Center for Firearm Violence Prevention and Intervention under the Department of Health. The WLC supports Governor Moore's public health approach for addressing the issue of gun violence in our communities.

As part of our mission, WLC provides legal services to survivors of intimate partner violence. Victims and survivors of intimate partner violence are at a heightened risk for death or injury due to gun violence. Firearms are involved in more than half of intimate partner homicides, and individuals facing intimate partner violence are five times more likely to be killed when their partner has access to a gun. We support the integrated approach in HB 583 of working with families, communities, and local officials in designing prevention and intervention strategies that are evidence-based.
