

## February 15, 2024 Department of Human Services-Children in Foster Care-Luggage House Bill 542

**Position: SUPPORT** 

The Maryland Association of Resources for Families and Youth (MARFY) is an association of private child caring organizations providing foster care, group homes, and other services through more than 200 programs across Maryland. The members of MARFY represent providers who serve Maryland's most vulnerable children who are in out of home placements due to abuse, neglect or severe mental health, and medical needs. We operate group homes, treatment foster care programs and independent living programs, primarily serving the foster care population as well as a juvenile services population.

House Bill 542 presents a crucial opportunity to address a fundamental issue affecting the dignity and self-worth of foster children: the provision of new luggage. For too long, many children in foster care have been forced to carry their belongings in trash bags during transitions between placements. This practice not only perpetuates feelings of shame and inadequacy but also undermines their sense of self-worth and dignity.

Passing this legislation would signify a powerful statement to these children, affirming that they are valued members of our community deserving of respect and consideration. By ensuring that each child receives brand-new luggage, we send a clear message that they are worthy of care and attention, regardless of their past experiences or circumstances.

It is imperative to recognize the profound impact that trauma, instability, and loss can have on a child's psyche. Providing them with their own new belongings, including luggage, serves as a tangible symbol of hope and renewal—a fresh start unencumbered by the shadows of their past. Every child deserves the opportunity to move forward with dignity and pride, unencumbered by the baggage of their past experiences.
