I believe that with so many people casting doubts about the integrity of our elections, the legislature should take steps to improve the process.

One way to overcome this perception is to establish voter identity.

This bill would do that.

However, I believe that the identification used should have a picture of the voter on it.

As such, I believe Section 10-310(a)(3)(II)(1) on page 2, line 8 should be removed.

The voter's voter registration card does not contain the voter's picture.

Moreover, many of the public does not have faith in the accuracy of the voter rolls, thus the use of this card would not increase the perception of increased integrity.
