WHAT DOES THIS BILL DO?

HB0047 ensures that girls who qualify for high school JV and Varsity girls' sports are competing against other biological girls. It is about protecting girls' opportunities for success in competitive sports. It is essential to have fairness and safety in sports for girls to hold state records, qualify for collegiate scholarships, and have higher levels of confidence and self-esteem.

WHY DO WE NEED THIS BILL?

Title IX's prohibition of sex discrimination is based on sex – male and female. It does not sanction males, with distinct physiological advantages regardless of treatment, to compete in female sports. We must recognize sex to ensure equal opportunity and fair competition.
