RE: HB 1515 – Oppose

Dear Chair Atterbeary and Members of the Committee:

Kaiser Permanente strongly opposes HB 1515. KP is the largest private integrated health care delivery system in the United States, delivering health care to over 12 million members in eight states and the District of Columbia.¹ Kaiser Permanente of the Mid-Atlantic States, which operates in Maryland, provides and coordinates complete health care services for over 825,000 members. In Maryland, we deliver care to approximately 475,000 members.

This legislation is a misguided attempt to fund critical priorities through a \$2.9 billion tax increase on Maryland residents and businesses. While HB 1515 proposes lowering the state sales tax rate from 6% to 5%, it would simultaneously expand the sales tax to a wide variety of everyday services that have never been taxed before, including health care.

Our industry already faces headwinds to keep healthcare affordable for Marylanders. For example, new medical technologies and treatments are constantly emerging, often at a very high price. Chronic diseases like diabetes and heart disease require ongoing, expensive management. Additionally, an aging population leads to a greater need for medical services.

We respectfully urge an unfavorable report to help our organization keep healthcare affordable for our members.
