HB 047 Education - Interscholastic and Intramural Junior Varsity and Varsity Teams - Designation Based on Sex (Fairness In Girls' Sports Act)

When I was growing up as a young female athlete in the 60's, there were very few opportunities for me to compete in an organized sport. Boys had teams, coaching, etc. And girls had to fend for themselves. When Title IX was passed, that changed everything.
