RE: HB 862 - Property Tax Exemption - Disabled Veterans - Service Connected Disability

Dear Chairwoman Atterbeary and Committee Members,

The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs supports HB 862 - Property Tax Exemption - Disabled Veterans - Service Connected Disability.

The MDVA believes it is important to recognize and honor the service of all veterans - including those who may have become disabled while serving in uniform. We acknowledge that veterans might have been provided a disability compensation rating of less than 100%, but continue to feel a significant impact from their service-connected disabilities. Easing the tax burden for these veterans shows them that their sacrifices are not forgotten by their community.

The MDVA supports lowering the eligibility threshold from 100% to 80% service-connected disability for veterans to receive this property tax exemption.

Thank you for your attention to this important proposal and I ask the committee for a favorable report on HB 862.
