

ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY DIAPER DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

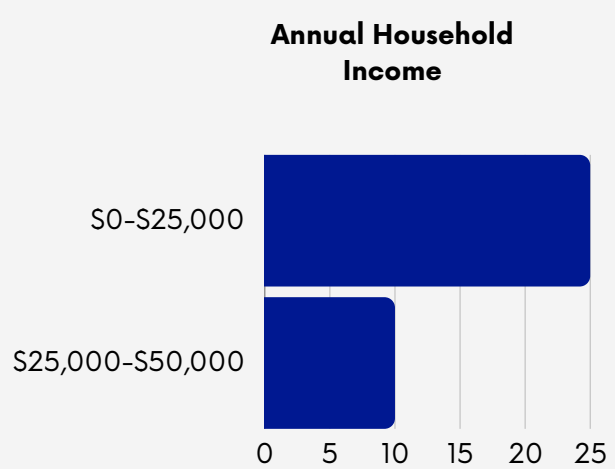
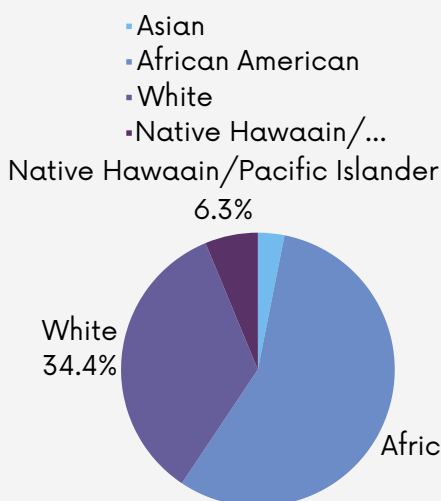


PROGRAM INFORMATION

Anne Arundel Community Action Agency (AACCAA) distributes diapers to 32 families in Anne Arundel County. The goal is to provide much-needed diapers to low-income families in the county so they can redirect resources to other basic needs.

AACCAA distributes diapers every other month. Families are given 200 diapers per child, which should equate to a two-month supply. Families also receive diaper wipes and diaper cream.

MONTHLY USAGE

1,650 reported diapers used monthly.

ESTIMATED COSTS

\$85.00 average monthly cost for diapers and diapering products

OUTCOMES

In addition to tracking the number of diapers distributed, number and ages of the children, The agency is working toward reporting on the outcomes below:

- Individual/family reductions in certain health issues (e.g., diaper rash, bladder infections).
- Increased rates of children enrolled in child care.
- Improved parent/caretakers' health and well-being (e.g., anxiety, depression).
- Improved school readiness (e.g., if children are in educational child care settings).
- Reduced economic stress.

OUTPUTS

Since October 2023, AACCAA has distributed 21,000 diapers, 840 diaper wipes and 70 diaper ointments for 35 children, ages 0-3.
