SB0765 - Out-of-Home Placement Providers - Individuals Enrolled in Higher Education and Vocational Training Programs House Appropriations Committee March 25, 2025

The Coalition to Protect Maryland's Children is a consortium of organizations and individuals formed in 1996 who are concerned about the care of Maryland's most vulnerable children and work together to promote meaningful child welfare reform. CPMC urges a favorable report on SB0765 - Out-of-Home Placement Providers - Individuals Enrolled in Higher Education and Vocational Training Programs.<sup>1</sup>

SB0765 seeks to clarify that any limitations on the number of children and youth residing in an out-of-home placement shall not prevent a college or vocational student returning to that foster care home during school breaks and holidays, a temporary closure of the institution, or a temporary leave of absence. Foster youth should not be concerned that the decision to attend college or vocational school means risks losing one's placement in their foster home. Currently, if a student were in the situation of not having space available in the foster family home, a waiver process can be initiated but with no guarantee of approval. All higher education and vocational training students should be able to pursue their academic goals without threats of housing instability.

It is for these reasons that the Coalition to Protect Maryland's Children **urges a favorable report** on SB0765 - Out-of-Home Placement Providers - Individuals Enrolled in Higher Education and Vocational Training Programs.
