My name is Kirk McCauley, my employer is WMDA/CAR, we represent service stations convenience stores and repair facilities across the state as a non-profit trade group.

Without a directory for allowed products this put retailers at risk of having products seized that could be legal and they would have to spend time and money receiving hearing and recover property.

Were this bill to move forward, "Seizure Without a Warrant," should be removed from SB842. Electronic Smoking Devices (ESD) enforcement for retailers should mirror those that are currently used for tobacco products. These procedures work for retailers and enforcement.
