

SB0316 Abundant Affordable Clean Energy Act Testimony before Education, Energy, and the Environment Hearing February 13, 2025 Position: Favorable

Dear Chair Feldman, Vice-Chair Kagan, and members of the committee,

My name is Julia Lawrence, and I represent the 800+ members of Indivisible Howard County. Indivisible Howard County is an active member of the Maryland Legislative Coalition (with 30,000+ members). We are providing written testimony today <u>in support of SB0316</u>, which would:

Create a comprehensive clean energy program that includes:

- 1. Battery storage to keep our grid reliable
- 2. Restructuring financing and procurement for solar programs
- 3. Providing support for existing in-state nuclear power

Protect ratepayers by:

- 1. Sharing profits from energy generation with customers
- 2. Capping costs for clean energy programs
- 3. Using data center tax revenue to offset energy costs

Prioritize in-state clean energy projects to reduce transmission costs and create local jobs.
