PG 307-25 State Highway Administration – Memorials Prince George's County - Maryland Route 210 in Prince George's

Delegation County

POSITION: SUPPORT

PG 307-25 introduced by the Prince George's County Delegation, directs the State Highway Administration (SHA) to install a memorial sign along a designated section of Maryland Route 210, also known as Piscataway Highway. This measure seeks to honor individuals who lost their lives in motor vehicle accidents on this historically hazardous roadway. By raising awareness of the ongoing need for safer driving conditions and emphasizing the importance of infrastructure improvements, this initiative provides a vital opportunity to commemorate those lost while striving to prevent future tragedies.

Maryland Route 210 has a tragic history of motor vehicle fatalities, and PG 307–25 demonstrates the State's commitment to honoring the lives lost while promoting safer roads. The proposed memorial sign serves as both a solemn reminder of past tragedies and a call to action, with its message encouraging shared responsibility for highway safety.
