Studies have shown that assistance with insurance payments for those who are struggling results is positive health outcomes. Preventative care can be done, people are healthier and that results in fewer ER visits. Those Emergency visits that do happen are at least partially covered by insurance. It is a win for all of us. It is the right thing as a community to do for those who have less than we do.
