Favorable HB 745 – State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists – Behavior Analysts

Dear Madam Chair Beidle and Members of the Senate Finance Committee,

Thank you for your consideration of HB 745 to help improve access to effective therapy for autism. One of the most beneficial therapies for children with autism is Applied Behavior Analysis. However, many families remain on waiting lists for services due to a severe shortage of qualified and licensed therapists. Turnaround time for the licensure process in Maryland is much longer than in neighboring States. This directly impacts the time a child must wait to begin receiving lifechanging services. The sooner licenses can be approved, the sooner children with autism can begin therapy and the more effective it will be.

HB 745 establishes a timeline for the issuance of a license to practice behavior analysis to a qualified applicant. This bill requires the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists to issue a license within 30 days of receiving the completed application; and requires the State Board to provide e-mail notification regarding the status of an application for a license to practice ABA.

This bill was unanimously passed out of the House. I respectfully request a favorable report on HB745.
