**Montgomery County – Alcoholic Beverages –
Beauty Salon and Barbershop License
MC 3-25**

House Bill 1095 extends the on-premises consumption license that holders of a State issued beauty salon permit may obtain to holders of a State issued barbering services permit. Further, the license is expanded to allow holders to serve a customer liquor, in addition to beer and wine. The bill specifies that the maximum amount of liquor that may be served is 1.7 ounces. Further, the bill increases from five to 12 ounces the maximum amount of beer that may be served.

Montgomery County supports House Bill 1095 and therefore requests that the Finance Committee advance this legislation.

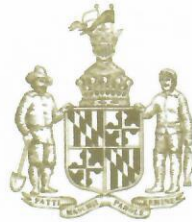

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after “Salon” insert “**and Barbershop**”; in line 4, after “of” insert “expanding eligibility for a certain beauty salon license in Montgomery County to include a holder of a certain barbershop permit;”; and in the same line, strike beginning with the second “a” through “County” and substitute “the license”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 2, after “salon” insert “**AND BARBERSHOP**”; in line 3, after “of” insert “;

(1);

in line 4, after “Article” insert “; **OR**

(2) A BARBERSHOP PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 4-501 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE”;
