## RE: HB 783 – Health Occupations – Structural Racism Training – Letter of Information

Dear Chair Peña-Melnyk and Committee Members:

The Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners is submitting this letter of information for SB 458 – Health Occupations – Structural Racism Training.

Effective December 11, 2023, licensed social workers in Maryland are required to complete 3 of their required CEUs at renewal with a focus on anti-oppressive social work practice. Please see below from COMAR 10.42.06.03A:

(d) 3 of the required Category I continuing education units shall have anti-oppressive social work practice content focusing on race, culture, or equity, and include one or more of the following topics: (i) Cultural humility; (ii) Social justice; (iii) Racial equity; (iv) Implicit bias; or (v) Anti-racism practices.

This information is provided to ensure that should this bill pass, the Board of Social Work Examiners will be prepared to comply. I hope this information is useful.
