The Maryland Community Health System (MCHS) supports *Senate Bill 156 – Universal Newborn Nurse Home Visiting Services – Program Establishment and Insurance Coverage.* The bill requires the Maryland Department of Health to establish a workgroup that develops a universal nurse home visiting program.

MCHS is a network of federally qualified health centers providing primary, behavioral, and dental care to underserved communities. We support evidence-based programs that reduce health disparities and improve health outcomes. Maryland should invest in home visiting programs for new parents.

MCHS looks forward to working with the Department and other stakeholders on delineating how the program would be implemented. Coordination with other healthcare providers will be the key to its success.
