Regarding the inquiry into Baltimore County's position on House Bill 316, Baltimore County does not hold a position on the legislation. As we understand 1-301, there should be no meaningful operational or fiscal change to our employees benefits as proposed by this legislation.

In addition, the job specifications for the County's 911 technicians meet the definition requirements of a "specialist" as outlined in current law; therefore, we do not believe the legislation to be impactful.
