

Dear Chair Smith and Members of the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee,

On behalf of the City of Mount Rainier, I write to express our strong support for **Senate Bill 390**, which enhances the efficiency and accuracy of Maryland's speed monitoring systems by allowing trained technicians, in addition to law enforcement officers, to certify violations recorded by these systems.

Speeding remains a persistent safety concern in our city, where pedestrian-friendly streets intersect with high-traffic corridors. Automated enforcement tools, such as speed cameras, play a vital role in our efforts to reduce speeding and prevent accidents.
