Honorable Chairwoman Atterbeary & Members of the House Ways & Means Committee:

SEIU Local 500 represents over 23,000 workers across Maryland. We wish to express our strong support for Senate Bill 342, the **Voting Rights Act of 2025**, which is a critical step toward ensuring fair and equitable elections in Maryland's counties and municipalities.

SB 342 establishes clear legal protections against election systems that dilute the voting power of protected classes, ensuring that all communities have an equal opportunity to elect candidates of their choice. By prohibiting election methods that impair the ability of minority groups to influence electoral outcomes, this bill strengthens democratic participation at the local level.

Key provisions of SB 342 include:
