Senate Bill 215 continues the great work of legislators from last session by updating statutes to reflect federal definitions, and replacing "armed forces" with the more inclusive and "uniformed services," which includes all eight branches. The bill also adds fees from special registration plates for recipients of "non-combat-related" uniformed services medals to go to the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund, which supports veterans and military families across the State.
