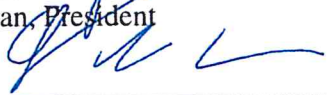
House Bill 1630 is a safety-driven measure designed to safeguard one of Maryland's most vital transportation corridors. We support this legislation and urge a favorable recommendation.

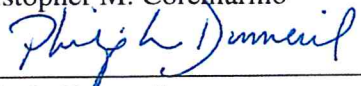

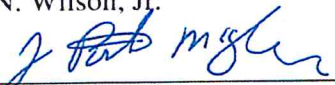
