The Secretary of Natural Resources proposes to amend Regulation .01 under COMAR 08.03.01 General Definitions.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this action is to establish a definition of what is considered to be a point on a white-tailed deer antler. The term point is used to define an antlered white-tailed deer and to establish whether an antlered deer meets any minimum antler size that may be required for legal harvest. This definition is needed because the Department is proposing to impose an antler point restriction on 1 of 3 of the antlered deer a hunter may take during the deer seasons starting in the fall of 2014. That restriction will be proposed in a change to COMAR 08.03.03.07.

Comparison to Federal Standards

There is no corresponding federal standard to this proposed action.

Estimate of Economic Impact

The proposed action has no economic impact.

.01 Definitions.

- A. In this subtitle, the following terms have the meanings indicated.
- B. Terms Defined.
- (1) "Antler point" means any antler projection, including the brow tine, at least one inch in length from base to tip. An antler point may project from the main beam or any antler tine. The brow tine is the point immediately above the top of the skull. The main antler beam tip shall be counted as a point, regardless of length.
 - (2) "Antlered sika deer" means a sika deer with at least one antler visible above the hairline.
