**Proposed Regulations
Department of Transportation**
(DLS Control No. 14-135)

Overview and Legal and Fiscal Impact

These regulations replace references to the Executive *Secretary* of the Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) with references to the Executive *Director* of MDTA in order to reflect the change in the position title.

The regulations present no legal issue of concern.

There is no fiscal impact on State or local agencies.

Legal Analysis

Summary of Regulations

The regulations replace references to the Executive *Secretary* of MDTA with references to the Executive *Director* of MDTA in provisions relating to permits, public notice of toll schedule revisions, and vehicle parking facilities. The Maryland Department of Transportation states that the regulations reflect the change in the position title.

Statutory Authority and Legislative Intent

The department cites § 4-205 as authority for the regulations. This section authorizes MDTA to adopt regulations to carry out its statutory mandate. This authority is correct and complete. The regulations comply with the legislative intent of the law.

Fiscal Analysis

There is no fiscal impact on State or local agencies.

Agency Estimate of Projected Fiscal Impact

The department advises that the regulations have no impact on State or local governments. The Department of Legislative Services concurs.

Impact on Budget

There is no impact on the State operating or capital budget.
