**Proposed Regulation
Department of Transportation**
(DLS Control No. 14-137)

Overview and Legal and Fiscal Impact

This regulation replaces a reference to the Executive *Secretary* of the Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) with a reference to the Executive *Director* of MDTA in order to reflect the change in the position title.

The regulation presents no legal issue of concern.

There is no fiscal impact on State or local agencies.

Legal Analysis

Summary of Regulation

This regulation replaces a reference to the Executive *Secretary* of MDTA with a reference to the Executive *Director* of MDTA in a provision relating to the Transportation Service Human Resources System. The Maryland Department of Transportation states that the regulation reflects the change in the position title.

Statutory Authority and Legislative Intent

The department cites §§ 2-102, 2-103.4, and 7-201 of the Transportation Article, and § 2-106 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article as authority for the regulation. However, proper authority for the regulation is found in § 4-205 of the Transportation Article, which authorizes MDTA to adopt regulations needed to carry out the statutory provisions governing MDTA. This authority is correct and complete. The regulation complies with the legislative intent of the law.

Fiscal Analysis

There is no fiscal impact on State or local agencies.

Agency Estimate of Projected Fiscal Impact

The department advises that the regulation has no impact on State or local governments. The Department of Legislative Services concurs.

Impact on Budget

There is no impact on the State operating or capital budget.

Agency Estimate of Projected Small Business Impact

The department advises that the regulation has minimal or no economic impact on small businesses in the State. The Department of Legislative Services concurs.
