Notice of Proposed Action

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The Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services proposes to , in cooperation with the Police Training Commission, amend Regulation .07 under COMAR 12.04.01 — General Regulations.

This action was considered by the Police Training Commission at a public meeting on July 9, 2014.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this action is to (1) Broaden training requirements for police officer recertification to address the case where an applicant was previously certified in Maryland as a police officer by the Police Training Commission and the applicant was last certified as a police officer within 3 years or less with a law enforcement agency in another state or the federal government; and

(2) Technical and clarifying changes.

Comparison to Federal Standards

There is no corresponding federal standard to this proposed action.

The proposed action has no economic impact.

.07 Police Officer Recertification.

B. *Police Officer* Recertification [Within] — 3 Years [of Separation] *or Less Since the Applicant was Last Certified as a Police Officer.*

(1) The Commission may recertify an applicant previously certified as a police officer in Maryland if:

(a) It has been [less than] 3 years *or less* since the applicant was certified as a police officer:

- (i) (text unchanged)
- (ii) With a law enforcement agency[,] *in* another state[,] or the federal government; and
- (b) The applicant meets the:
 - (i) Selection standards under Regulation .08 of this chapter; [and]
 - (ii) In-service training requirements under §B(3) of this regulation[.]; *and*
 - (iii) *If the applicant was last certified as a police officer with a law enforcement agency in another state or the federal government, training requirements under Regulation .14E(7) of this chapter.*

- C. Police Officer Recertification[after Separation for] — *After More Than 3 Years and Not More Than 5 Years Since the Applicant was Last Certified as a Police Officer.*
