.02 Definitions.

- A. In this chapter, the following terms have the meanings indicated.
- B. Terms Defined.
- (1) "Act" means *General Provisions Article, Title 4*, Annotated Code of Maryland.

- (9) "Sociological data" means any of the following information concerning a person about whom a record is maintained by the Department of State Police:
- (a) Social security number;
 - (b) *Date of birth*;
 - (c) *Driver's license number*;
 - [b](d) Personal address;
 - [c](e) Personal phone number;
 - [d](f) Any information obtained by a personal history investigation;
 - [e](g) Any information obtained through a doctor's examination;
 - [f](h) Any score from a GED certificate;
 - (i) Any transcript or information obtained from a high school, college, or other approved educational institution; and
 - (j) Any information regarding marital status or dependents.
