**Notice of Proposed Action**

The Secretary of Natural Resources proposes to repeal Regulation .11 of COMAR 08.03.10 General Wildlife Hunting Regulations.

**Statement of Purpose**

The purpose of this action is to repeal the Regulation that declares the monetary values of certain wildlife species. A new regulation is being proposed under COMAR 08.03.16 Hunting Privilege, Suspension and Restitution that declares the monetary values of certain groups of wildlife. The new regulation may be used by the courts when imposing restitution fees for hunting violations. COMAR 08.03.10.11 will be repealed so as to not conflict with the new monetary value regulation.

**Comparison to Federal Standards**

There is no corresponding federal standard to this proposed action.

**Estimate of Economic Impact**

The proposed action has no economic impact.
