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## SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 20, 2013

### **SB 998**     **Senator Brinkley**

#### SECONDHAND PRECIOUS METAL OBJECT DEALERS AND PAWNBROKERS – EXEMPTIONS FOR AUCTIONEERS

Exempting auctioneers from the licensing and regulatory requirements for secondhand precious metal object dealers and pawnbrokers; and defining specified terms.

#### MARYLAND CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN OF 2003 – ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY – ANNAPOLIS RECREATIONAL CENTER AT 9 ST. MARY’S STREET

Amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003 to alter the purpose of a grant for a specified recreational center to allow the funds to be used for the Annapolis City Hall; extending the deadline to June 1, 2014, for the Mayor and City Council of the City of Annapolis to present evidence of a matching fund; extending the deadline to June 1, 2014, for specified funds to be expended or encumbered; etc.

MARYLAND CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN OF 2010 –  
PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY – WALKER MILL DAYCARE AND  
TRAINING CENTER

Amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010 to extend the deadline for the Board of Directors of Walker Mill Development, Inc. to present evidence that a matching fund will be provided; providing that the grant may not terminate before June 1, 2014; etc.

Extending to the end of December 31, 2015, the termination date of provisions of law that provide for notice of service on a respondent of specified protective orders.

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY –  
CHEVERLY AMERICAN LEGION POST 108

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$40,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Executive Committee of the Cheverly American Legion Post 108, Inc. for the construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Cheverly American Legion Post 108, located in Cheverly; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; etc.

**SB 1003 Senator Raskin****CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – MONTGOMERY COUNTY – EASTER SEALS INTER-GENERATIONAL CENTER EXPANSION**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Easter Seals of Greater Washington–Baltimore Region, Inc. for the construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Easter Seals Inter–Generational Center, located in Silver Spring; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

**SB 1004 Calvert County Senators****CALVERT COUNTY – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – SUNDAY SALES**

Making inapplicable in Calvert County the prohibition against a holder of a Class B or Class C license from selling alcoholic beverages at a bar or counter on Sunday.

**SB 1005 Senator Klausmeier****BALTIMORE COUNTY – COMMISSION TO STUDY THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TRUANCY REDUCTION PROGRAM**

Establishing the Commission to Study the Establishment of a Truancy Reduction Program in Baltimore County; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the Commission from receiving specified compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of specified expenses; requiring the Commission to study and make recommendations regarding specified matters; requiring the Commission to report its findings and recommendations to specified individuals; etc.

**SB 1006 Senator Pipkin****VEHICLE-MILES-TRAVELED TAX – PROHIBITED ACTS**

Prohibiting the State from imposing or levying a vehicle-miles-traveled tax or other similar fees, tolls, or taxes; and prohibiting the State from requiring the installation of a device in or on a privately owned vehicle or using an odometer reading to facilitate the reporting of the number of vehicle miles traveled for the purpose of calculating a tax, fee, toll, or any other levy.

**SB 1007 Senator Pipkin****CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY – KENNARD HIGH SCHOOL RESTORATION PROJECT**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Kennard Alumni Association, Inc. for the repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of Kennard High School, located in Centreville; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

**SB 1008 Senator Pipkin****SEWAGE SLUDGE UTILIZATION PERMITS – CHESAPEAKE AND ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS CRITICAL AREA – JUDICIAL REVIEW**

Applying specified standing requirements, legal processes for judicial review of environmental permits, and a specified prohibition against contested case hearings to specified sewage sludge utilization permits issued for land in the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Critical Area.

**SB 1009** Senator MiddletonSPECIAL THOROUGHBRED RACING – STATE FAIR SOCIETY –  
RACING DAYS

Increasing from 10 to 25 the maximum number of days authorized for a race meeting held by the State Fair Society.

**SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION INTRODUCED February 20, 2013****SJ 3** Senator PetersCRISIS IN WAITING PERIODS FOR VETERANS WITH DISABILITIES  
TO RECEIVE SERVICES FROM THE FEDERAL VETERANS BENEFITS  
ADMINISTRATION

Urging that specified actions be taken by Congress, the federal Department of Veterans Affairs, and the federal Veterans Benefits Administration to address the long waiting periods for veterans with disabilities who file disability compensation claims with the Baltimore Regional Office to receive services and compensation from the federal Veterans Benefits Administration; and providing that a copy of the resolution be forwarded by the Department of Legislative Services to specified individuals.
