SENATE BILL INTRODUCED *March 4, 2013*

SB 1055 Senator Manno, et al

STATE AID FOR CRITICAL SERVICES – COUNTY MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT REQUIREMENTS

Requiring each county, beginning in fiscal year 2015, to appropriate at least the same amount of local funds to specified categories of critical services as the county appropriated in the prior fiscal year; requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management to withhold specified State aid if a county does not meet specified maintenance of effort requirements in specified categories of critical services; requiring the Secretary to disburse specified withheld State aid if specified maintenance of effort requirements are met; etc.

SENATE BILL INTRODUCED March 5, 2013**SB 1056 Senator Ferguson****ELECTION LAW – INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES AND ELECTIONEERING COMMUNICATIONS – DISCLOSURE**

Requiring a person who makes a specified amount of independent expenditures or electioneering communications to register and file specified reports with the State Board of Elections within a specified time; requiring an independent expenditure or electioneering communication report to identify persons who made donations of a specified amount to the person making the independent expenditure or electioneering communication; etc.

SENATE BILL REASSIGNED March 5, 2013**SB 1026 Senator Colburn****HONEY – LICENSE EXEMPTIONS**

Altering the definition of “raw agricultural product” to include honey and herb mixtures and flavored honey; and exempting a person that manufactures, processes, or sells honey and herb mixtures or flavored honey from the requirement to obtain an on-farm home processing facility license or permit.
