SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED *March 25, 2013*

SB 1073 Senator Pipkin

TASK FORCE TO EVALUATE THE QUALITY OF PATIENT CARE UNDER A CAPITATED PAYMENT SYSTEM

Establishing the Task Force to Evaluate the Quality of Patient Care Under a Capitated Payment System; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to study matters related to the impact of moving from a per case to a per capita payment model; requiring the Task Force to report its findings to the Governor and specified committees of the General Assembly on or before January 1, 2014; terminating the Act after June 30, 2014; etc.

TASK FORCE TO EVALUATE THE IMPACT OF MARYLAND'S PROPOSAL TO MAINTAIN THE MEDICARE WAIVER

Establishing the Task Force to Evaluate the Impact of Maryland's Proposal to Maintain the Medicare Waiver; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to study specified matters related to a specified waiver application; requiring the Task Force to report its findings to the Governor and specified standing committees of the General Assembly on or before January 1, 2014; terminating the Act after June 30, 2014; etc.

STATE MEDICARE WAIVERS – APPLICATIONS, REAPPLICATIONS, MODIFICATIONS, OR AMENDMENTS – LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL REQUIRED

Prohibiting the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and the Health Services Cost Review Commission from submitting to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services an application for a State Medicare waiver, or a reapplication, a modification, or an amendment to an existing Medicare waiver, until the General Assembly takes specified action.
