SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED January 28, 2014

SB 499 Senator Pugh

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – COPPIN HEIGHTS URBAN REVITALIZATION PROJECT – PHASE I

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$140,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Coppin Heights Community Development Corporation for specified development or improvement purposes related to the Coppin Heights Urban Revitalization Project, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; etc.

SB 500 Senator Pugh**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – DRUID HILL PARK AT AUCHENTOROLY TERRACE**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Parks and People Foundation, Inc. for specified development or improvement purposes related to Druid Hill Park, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; etc.

SB 501 Senator Pugh**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – BALTIMORE DESIGN SCHOOL**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Fashion, Architecture and Basic Design School, Inc. for specified development or improvement purposes related to the Baltimore Design School, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; etc.

SB 502 Senator Pugh**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – SKATEPARK OF BALTIMORE AT ROOSEVELT PARK**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$150,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Skatepark of Baltimore, Inc. for specified development or improvement purposes related to the skatepark at Roosevelt Park, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; etc.

SB 503 Senator Pugh, et al**PUBLIC SCHOOLS – CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR INSTRUCTION – GRADUATION REQUIREMENT (BREANNA’S LAW)**

Requiring a public school student to complete instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator to graduate from high school, beginning with students entering grade 9 in the 2015–2016 school year; requiring each county board of education to provide instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillator use in specified schools beginning in the 2015–2016 school year, using a specified instructional program, and incorporating specified skills; etc.

SENATE BILL REASSIGNED January 27, 2014**SB 374** Senator Currie, et al**STATE LOTTERY – ONLINE TICKET SALES – MORATORIUM AND STUDY**

Prohibiting the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency from allowing a person to purchase a State lottery ticket through an electronic device that connects to the Internet; establishing the Task Force to Study the Online Sale of State Lottery Tickets; requiring the Task Force to study and make determinations regarding the sale of State lottery tickets over the Internet; requiring the Task Force to report its findings, determinations, and any recommendations on or before January 1, 2015; etc.
