SB 131 Senator McFadden

MARYLAND CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOANS OF 2012 AND 2013 – BALTIMORE CITY – L.A.M.B. COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTER

Amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2012 and 2013 to repeal the requirements that the Board of Directors of L.A.M.B. provide a matching fund for the LAMB Community Resource Center project; etc.

SB 132 Senator McFadden**MARYLAND CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN OF 2006 –
BALTIMORE CITY – FOREST PARK SENIOR CENTER**

Amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 to repeal a requirement that the Board of Directors of The Forest Park Senior Center, Inc. provide a matching fund for the Forest Park Senior Center project; providing that the grant may not terminate before June 1, 2015; etc.

SB 133 Senators Miller and Middleton**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – CHARLES COUNTY – RICH HILL
FARMHOUSE**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of Charles County for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of Rich Hill Farmhouse; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

SB 134 The President (By Request – Administration)**MARYLAND HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN – ACCESS FOR BRIDGE
ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS**

Altering the purpose of the Maryland Health Insurance Plan to include decreasing uncompensated care costs by providing access to affordable, comprehensive health benefits for specified bridge eligible individuals; providing that it is the intent of the General Assembly that Maryland Health Insurance Plan Fund revenue be used to subsidize health insurance coverage for specified bridge eligible individuals; etc.

SB 135 **Senator Glassman**

WATERSHED PROTECTION AND RESTORATION PROGRAM –
ENFORCEMENT BY DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT –
MORATORIUM

Prohibiting the Department of the Environment from taking an administrative action to enforce specified watershed protection and restoration program requirements or imposing a penalty for a violation of specified provisions of law or regulations before July 1, 2015.
